ENERGY MINISTER MEETS CONCERNED CITIZENS ON GOVERNMENTS ALUMINIUM INDUSTRY

Energy Minister, Senator the Honourable Conrad Enill today met a small group of concerned citizens at his Energy Tower Offices at the International Waterfront Centre.

The Minister met for two hours and had wide ranging discussions on the following issues:

1. The concerns of persons in the buffer zone;
2. The promises that were made and are yet to be delivered; and
3. The need for ongoing dialogue on the project.

It was agreed that the group would submit their concerns to the Minister in writing and a further meeting will be held to discuss the progress on matters identified by the key stakeholders and project-affected communities.
