Energy Minister Franklin Khan meets with Ghanaian Delegation

Energy Minister Franklin Khan met with representatives from the Ministry of Finance and Petroleum Division of the Ghana Revenue Authority, at the Ministry of Energy's Head Office in Port-of-Spain on Monday 8th May, 2017. The delegation, led by the Honourable Kwaku Agyeman Kwarteng, MP, Deputy Minister of Finance is in Trinidad and Tobago to discuss best practice for revenue capture along the petroleum value chain as well as the spin – off industries, at the midstream level of the value chain that would contribute to GDP.

During the, Minister Khan stated, “we have a fairly good structure in Trinidad and Tobago and we are more than happy to share our history and experience in the Energy Sector with our Ghanaian counterparts.”
