# Request for Proposals (RFPs)

# For the Supply of an Unmanned Aerial System for the Minerals Sector

July 2, 2020

#### 1. Introduction

The Minerals Act Chapter 61:03 governs the regulation of the Minerals Sector in Trinidad and Tobago. In accordance with this piece of legislation, the Minister of Energy and Energy Industries, under whose portfolio the mining sector falls, is responsible for the general administration of the Act, and the Director of Minerals is responsible for the implementation of the Act.

In this regard, the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries (MEEI) calls for Request for Proposals (RFPs) from interested entities for the supply of a suitable Unmanned Aerial System (UAS). This UAS technology is aimed at assisting in carrying out the monitoring, surveillance and enforcement functions of the Minerals Division as outlined below:

- 1) To calculate volumes of minerals removed for the verification of mineral production and royalties owed by licensees.
- 2) To monitor activity of operators, such as quantification of acreage, verifying boundaries between operations and neighbouring State Lands, etc.
- 3) To conduct surveillance in areas with unregulated mining operations, where the shortage of resources, staff, vehicles and security are currently major challenges.

### 2. Submission Guidelines

Proposals should be submitted in accordance with this RFP, and submissions will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria specified herein. Submissions should address the following categories and include the following items as listed below.
