MINISTER YOUNG MEETS WITH DENOVO

The Honourable Stuart R. Young SC, MP, Minister of Energy and Energy Industries and Minister in the Office of the Prime Minister, along with Ms. Sandra Fraser, Permanent Secretary at the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries, met with DeNovo Energy Limited executives at the at the Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries', International Waterfront Complex Head-Office, on 9th July, 2024.

The DeNovo Energy Limited executives present at the meeting were, Mr. Bryan Ramsumair, Managing Director and Mr. Kris Sookdeo, Commercial Manager, DeNovo Energy Limited.

Having invested in the Iguana and Zandolie projects, the DeNovo Energy Limited executives expressed interest in further investments into Trinidad and Tobago's energy sector.
