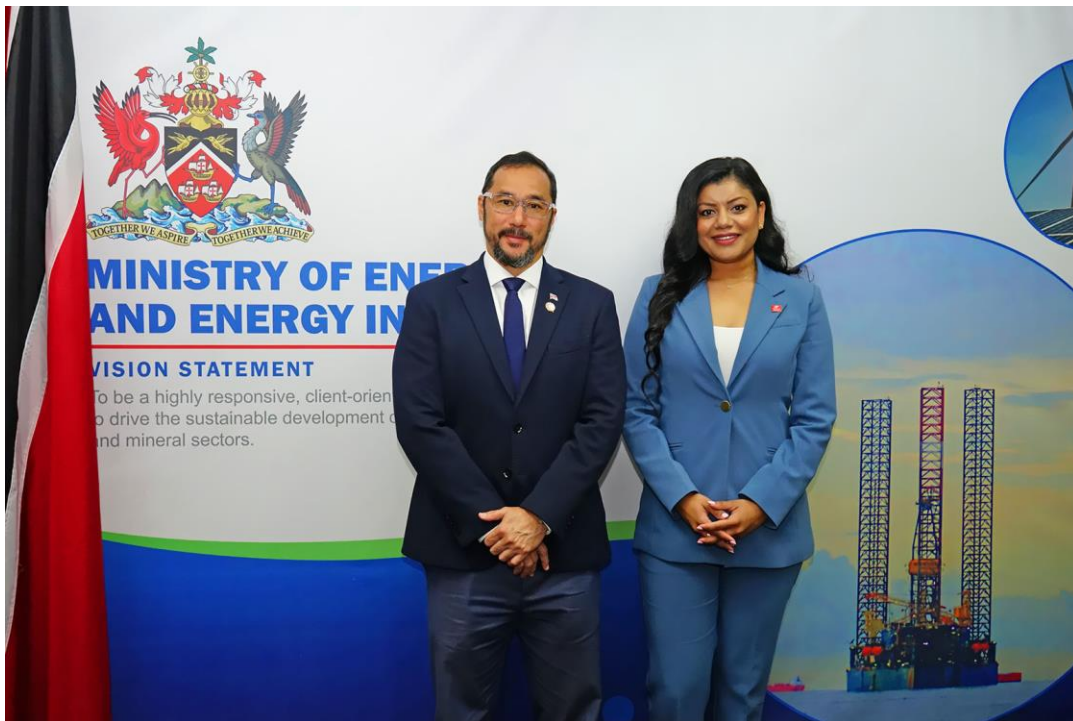
With respect to the Calypso deep water project, marketing and commercial discussions remain ongoing, under the company's exploration and development portfolio.
